

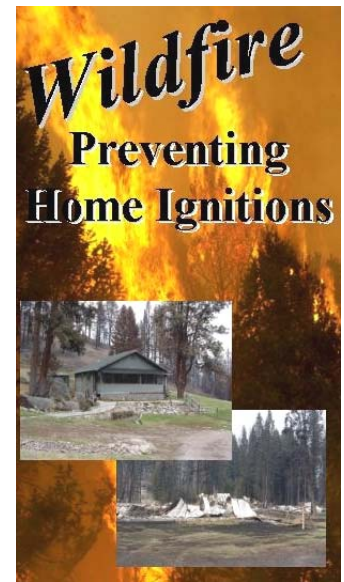
What can YOU do to help firefighters?
